#### Wining and dining

For those who prefer to ring in the holiday at their favorite pub, there are a few noteworthy events taking place around Taipei.

Brass Monkey, at 166 Fuxing N Rd, Taipei City (台北市復興北路166號), is having a buffet dinner from 6pm to 10pm for NT\$799 including a beer or glass of wine. Making a reservation secures a table for the night; otherwise, cover for the party to follow from 10pm to 4am is NT\$300 for men with two drinks or free for women. DJ Paul Energy will be spinning pop, hip-hop, house and Latin tunes.

On Tap's only requirement is that people spend a minimum of NT\$500 to drink "in the shadow of Taipei 101," though it's worth noting that on Sundays the bar has an all-day "Power Hour" from noon to 9pm with regular drinks for NT\$99 and a new brunch menu. On Tap is located at 49, Ln 308, Guangfu S Rd, Taipei City (台北市光復 南联308共40縣)

Bliss, under new management, has taken a radical turn from last year's party that had multiple bands upstairs for NT\$200 and no cover downstairs. This year Soul, Sweat, and Swank DJs Grant Pullman and Paul Duffy will be playing soul, funk, R 'n' B and rock, with drink specials including NT\$100 tequila shots during the night. Cover charge is NT\$500 with tables offered by reservation: NT\$3,000 for the three-top by the window downstairs to NT\$8,000 for an eight-top. The reservation charge includes entry for seated guests with one bottle of champagne for the smaller tables and two for the larger. Bliss is located at 148, Xinyi Rd Sec 4, Taipei City (台北市信義路四段148號).

Convenience stores selling beer, wine and spirits still have no cover charge for New Year's Eve. Seating on the steps outside is, as

always, first-come first-serve.

The MRT in Taipei is scheduled to run all night for New Year's Eve, but be wary of huge crowds and restricted access to stations around the Xinyi District. Please make sure not to drink and drive, and best of luck with those resolutions for 2009.

### The show goes on

From the fireworks at Taipei 101 to celebrity-studded concerts across the country, there's something for everyone this New Year's Eve

ON Wednesday night people all around Taiwan will be putting their woes — financial and otherwise — behind them and counting down to the beginning of a New Year. Wherever you are around the country, there is a party somewhere near you, where the traditional entertainments of music and fireworks will be on hand to liven up the hours as the clock ticks down to midnight.

The biggest event will probably be the gathering in front of the Taipei City Government building at 1 Shifu Rd, Taipei City (台北市市府路1號), where hosts Hu Gua (胡瓜) and Pauline Lan (藍心湄) will start warming up the crowd at 7pm. The highpoint of the evening will be the Taipei 101 fireworks, which people will be able to see from many locations across the city, even if they are unwilling to brave the cold and the

crowd on the ground. The payoff for heading down to the Xinyi District will be music by some of Taiwan's hottest acts, including Sodagreen (蘇打綠), Mayday (五月天), A-Mei (張惠妹), Jam Hsiao (蕭敬騰), MC Hotdog (熱狗), S.H.E and others. The party runs until 1am on Thursday.

If you want to watch the fireworks from way up high, a number of options are available. If you really want to get up close, there's the observation deck of Taipei 101 itself. New Year packages are available starting at NT\$700. Tickets including a sunrise breakfast on Jan. 1 start at NT\$2,100 for two. Detailed ticketing information can be found at 101.

To take in the big picture, you really can't do much better than ride the Miramar (美麗華) Ferris wheel in Taipei's Neihu District, which is offering a range of packages for those who want to get a bird's eye view of the festivities. A package for four persons, which includes a cabin on the Ferris wheel, movie tickets, beer and food from Le Bie d'Or (金色三麥), and free giveaways starts from NT\$2,009.
